Gastrointestinal tuberculosis is an infrequent site for the development of tuberculous infection in the human host. It is usually associated with a primary infection or the reactivation of a latent infection in the form of tuberculous peritonitis, primary peritonitis, or miliary tuberculosis. The average time interval between primary infection and presentation of gastrointestinal symptoms is 9 months. Although gastrointestinal tuberculosis can involve the most unusual sites, abdominal pain and intestinal obstruction are the most frequent symptoms at presentation. Pulmonary tuberculosis, unless disseminated, usually is the most important source of the infection. However, in this syndrome there are other minor sources of infection, such as enteric organisms, which should be considered. Gastrointestinal tuberculosis is usually diagnosed by a careful history, physical examination, and barium studies. Definitive diagnosis can usually be made by gastric biopsy and histologic examination for acid-fast bacilli and by culture of mycobacterium tuberculosis from specimens obtained at surgery. A high index of suspicion is the mainstay of diagnosis.
