Clinical Trials The Pfizer Center is registered with the U.S. Office of Human Research Protections (HRP), the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the National Institutes of Health, and other applicable authorities as a Cooperative Research and Development Alliance (CRADA) institution. A CRADA is a formal partnership between a government agency (the FDA or the NIH) and an academic institution or a commercial company that is designed to provide for the conduct of important clinical trials. Through CRADAs, Pfizer and the U.S. government identify and prioritize clinical research that is of high priority to the federal government, in order to maximize the potential for patient benefit and to help protect the public health. The Center is a "qualified investigator" meaning that the Center can apply to sponsor investigator-initiated trials as well as cooperative trials and trials in which the FDA has the lead role. The Center provides broad drug development services to top-line pharmaceutical companies. The Center is located in convenient downtown Princeton, NJ. The Center provides services that are critical for the development and commercialization of new drugs and vaccines.
