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Photoshop: An Overview Despite its name, Photoshop isn't a single program — it's a suite of tools for various types of digital image manipulation. These tools have their own menu items, and you can use them either together or one by one to create an image. Each tool has a unique icon and function, and you can choose to use them all at once or use them one by one. Each tool also comes with a high-level user interface (UI) that enables you to access some of Photoshop's most commonly used tools. You can start creating your graphics in the UI instead of learning all the tool and menu commands from the help file. ## Using Tools Photoshop has a bunch of tools — there are menus, buttons, and palettes. Not all of them are obvious at first, so here is a quick rundown on the few tools you'll need to start manipulating images. To get a feel for the tools, try using them to create your own graphic. Practice doing two-and three-frame composites using Photoshop's tools. Always remember to make a copy of your file before making changes to your image. Use the Clone Stamp tool to make a copy (use a Clone Source preset if you want to) and then change the image. When you save your file, save a second copy with a different name as a backup.

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Backing up your Adobe Photoshop Elements You should back up your Adobe Photoshop Elements before you begin to edit images. Adobe Photoshop Elements backs up your Photoshop Elements files automatically. When you back up Photoshop Elements, it copies your application settings, customized themes, and preferences. You can back up your images, and you can create Photoshop Elements backups. Back up your images To back up your images, follow these steps: Set up your preferences. You set up preferences for the application. Open the Save For Web & Devices window. In the image files tab, select images you want to back up. In the Compressed file size field, enter the file size limit you want to back up. In the Compression type field, select JPEG 2000 for a good compression ratio. In the Quality field, select Custom for the highest quality setting. In the field, enter a file name or select an existing file. Select the images to include in the backup. You can select individual images, a folder, or an entire image collection. Create a Photoshop Elements backup You can back up only images you created with Elements. To create a Photoshop Elements backup: Open the Save for Web & Devices window. Select Photoshop Elements application data and image files. Select the check box to include the application settings, themes, and preferences. Save the Photoshop Elements backup. The backup is available immediately as an Adobe Elements backup file. You can rename the file to make it more descriptive, and you can locate the file in your downloads folder. Protect Photoshop Elements preferences When you use different computers to work with Photoshop Elements, you need to protect the preferences you set up the first time. Use this procedure to protect the settings for the application. Open the Save For Web & Devices window. In the image files tab, select image files you want to protect. In the Compressed file size field, enter a file size limit. In the Compression type field, select JPEG 2000 for a good compression ratio. In the Quality field, select Custom for the highest quality setting. Select the images you want to protect from the selection. Select the check box to include the application settings, themes, and preferences. Save the Photoshop Elements preferences. A new window opens. Click 05a79cecff

[Treatment of microtia and microtopia and surgical correction of the skull]. This report presents our experience with the treatment of the microtia and microtopia. Between 1987 and 1996, a total of 948 operations were carried out in our clinic. The microtia was in the majority. The first stage of the treatment included primary correction of the skeletal deformities. The use of osteoplastic flaps led to an improvement in the results. Subsequently the wound was covered with vascularised and non-vascularised flaps. The indication for the use of skin-flaps was a defect of the external ear. Due to problems during surgical excision of the cartilaginous framework of the ear in 14 patients, the external ear was reconstructed with solid silicon implants in 6 cases and silicone implants in 8 cases.Hamid Reza Zonabadi Hamid Reza Zonabadi (, Persian:) is an Iranian artist and director known for his documentary work. Zonabadi's documentaries usually explore socially relevant subjects including social exclusion, the influence of the media, culture, religion, family and corruption. Zonabadi has worked with prominent filmmakers, including Abbas Kiarostami and Masoud Kimiai, as a cinematographer, director and actor. It was around this time that he started experimenting with film making and photography.
